We recently launched an updated website at <u>www.firstgeneseo.org</u>. The new site better integrates with other software we use in the church and gives us more flexibility in the future. It has the same features as before, including: important announcements on our home page, featured events, full calendar of events, live streams of sermons, video archives, a members-only section, information on our ministries and outreach, and a way to submit prayer requests:

- Go to Welcome on the main navigation and then scroll down and click on Member Access.
- You will be prompted for a password. The password is First!
- Once you are logged in, scroll to the section called Submit a Prayer Request.
- Fill out the form with the required information if you or someone you know would like to be added to our Lifelines Prayer List.

By submitting a prayer online, you are indicating you have obtained permission to share and print the names of all persons involved. Submitted prayers will be on our Lifelines Prayer List for six weeks and may be renewed. Prayers will be updated weekly in First Day, which can be viewed in the Member Access section. If you are a member and would like to join our E-Prayer (email prayer chain) for dedicated prayer at home, please contact the office at Prayer@FirstGeneseo.org for details.

Several unique worship opportunities are happening this month in our area. Join siblings in Christ from other congregations to worship and praise our God!



Did you know ... First Book Club plans to continue meeting monthly during the summer! Come and join us for discussion on the content of the book *We Were the Lucky Ones* and faith response to the author Georgia Hunter on Thursday, June 19 at 2 p.m. in Grace Place.

It is the spring of 1939 and three generations of the Kurc family are doing their best to live normal lives, even as the shadow of war grows closer. The talk around the family Seder table is of new babies and budding romance, not of the increasing hardships threatening Jews in their hometown of Radom, Poland. But soon the horrors overtaking Europe will become inescapable and the Kurcs will be flung to the far corners of the world, each desperately trying to navigate his or her own path to safety. As one sibling is forced into exile, another attempts to flee the continent, while others struggle to escape certain death, either by working grueling hours on empty stomachs in the factories of the ghetto or by hiding as gentiles in plain sight. Driven by an unwavering will to survive and by the fear that they may never see one another again, the Kurcs must rely on hope, ingenuity, and inner strength to persevere. 
