A WORD FROM PASTOR LAURA

All Creatures of our God and King

I was blessed to get to spend a full week at camp this past month with 3 of our Confirmation students. In addition to the human creatures who shared the week with us, we were joined by many more of God's beloved creatures: chipmunks, squirrels, rabbits, groundhogs, turtles, spiders, bees, deer, hawks, and wild turkeys (including a mama turkey and her 4 chicks). The camp experience is a holy one: the time is set apart for God's special purposes. Each day begins and ends in worship. New relationships are formed – friendships with fellow campers and counselors. And each camper's relationship with God is renewed.

On the final full day of camp, the counselors led the campers through an experience called "Eco-Stations of the Cross." Each station along the short hike used land, trees, and wildlife to mark significant points along Jesus' passion. As the campers recalled Jesus' suffering and sacrifice, and finally Jesus' resurrected life, they prayed for the environment, which also suffers greatly and sacrifices so much of itself. They prayed for renewal, and restoration, and resurrection for this world God so loves. I will be spending time this coming month preparing for the Season of Creation, which we will celebrate in worship during September. The resources we will use have been prepared for us by the Creation Care Subcommittee of the Northern Illinois Synod. The team met here at Lutheran Outdoor Ministries Center several years ago while compiling and writing these worship resources. This year, we will celebrate Ocean & Lake Sunday; Animal

Compassion International is an organization that works to end child poverty by connecting vulnerable children with churches through child sponsorship and other child initiatives. These sponsorships help provide medical care, fight malnutrition, protect children from harm, and share the hope of the gospel. When children are cared for, mind, body and soul, they go from surviving to thriving with the resources they need to break the chains of poverty.

Compassion means seeing the suffering of others, deeply caring and taking action to stop it. As the hands and feet of Jesus, it's our responsibility to care for those living in poverty. An effective way to do that is through sponsorship. A sponsor's support is a life-changing way to show these children how valuable and loved they truly are. Being loved and chosen by a sponsor fights the lies of poverty and speaks loudly to the child about their worth. First Book Club

Come and join us for discussion on the content of the book *The Vanishing Half* and faith response to the author Brit Bennett on Thursday, August 21 at 2 p.m. in Grace Place.

"The Vanishing Half" tells the story of twin sisters, Desiree and Stella Vignes, who grow up in the small, insular town of Mallard, Louisiana, where residents are predominantly light-skinned Black individuals. At sixteen, they run away to New Orleans, but their lives diverge dramatically. Stella chooses to "pass" as white, severing ties with her family and creating a new life for herself in California with a white husband and daughter, while Desiree returns to Mallard with her dark-skinned daughter, Jude, after an abusive relationship. The novel explores the themes of identity, race, family secrets, and the lasting impact of choices across generations, as the sisters and their daughters navigate their intertwined but separate lives. Be sure to read this critically acclaimed novel and join our discussion!
