<p><u>2nd Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bible Adventures <p>Children and their families come together to learn about God's written word. We will explore the Bible and talk about ways to utilize the Bible together as a family.</p> <p>Event: September 14 ~ 3:30-5 p.m.</p> <p>Blessing: September 21</p>	<p><u>3rd Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come to the Table <p>Children and their families learn about how God feeds us in the special meal of Holy Communion. Children of any age are welcome to participate in this Milestone with our 3rd graders, especially if they are ready to begin receiving the Sacrament.</p> <p>Event: March 8, 22 & 29 ~ 4 p.m.</p> <p>Blessing: April 2 (<i>Maundy Thursday</i>)</p>	<p><u>4th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stewardship (Kids and Money) <p>Participants will learn how stewardship is not just about money - but our lives, health, bodies, souls, minds, hearts, relationships, time, ideas, dreams, questions, stories, passions and all of creation.</p> <p>Event: November 2 ~ 4-5 p.m.</p> <p>Blessing: November 9</p>
<p><u>5th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fruit of the Spirit <p>As our 5th graders prepare for Middle School, we learn about the Fruits of the Spirit and how the Holy Spirit equips us for a faith-filled life in every setting.</p> <p>Event: April 12 ~ 3:30-5 p.m.</p> <p>Blessing: April 19</p>	<p><u>6th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quest <p>6th graders ask and explore the big "Quest"ions of faith, with a new theme each month, September through March.</p> <p>Blessing: TBD</p>	<p><u>7th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entering Confirmation <p>A celebration of the beginning of the 2- year confirmation journey at First— a profound time of faith formation for our young people.</p> <p>Blessing: August 24</p>

<p><u>8th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apostles' Creed <p>The Apostles' Creed is an affirmation of faith. Students will learn how to express what they believe by using three "I believe" statements to explain who God is, what God has done and what God continues to do in the world.</p> <p>Event: April 29 ~ 12 p.m. (Half day of school)</p> <p>Blessing: May 3</p>	<p><u>9th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Affirmation of Baptism <p>The Affirmation of Baptism liturgy in worship, in which students say "yes" to their baptism and continued life of faith, is a celebration in the life of families and the congregation.</p> <p>Blessing: October 26</p>	<p><u>10th Grade</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blessing of the Keys <p>A celebration for those who have received or will receive a driver's license this year.</p> <p>Blessing: August 10</p>
<p><u>All Kids</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Back To School Blessing <p>Students of all ages, teachers, school staff, and faith formation volunteers will be blessed as they begin a new school year.</p> <p>Blessing: August 10</p>	<p><u>Adults & Kids</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walking Wet: Anniversary of Baptism <p>On the Baptism of our Lord, we will celebrate all those who have been baptized in the past year. Families will be invited to receive a blessing and blessing stone during worship.</p> <p>Blessing: January 11</p>	<p>The "<i>Event</i>" always educates about the milestone and offers engaging, experiential, cross-generational learning opportunities. They may be a single session or two or more.</p> <hr/> <p>The "<i>Blessing</i>" offers a litany and blessing and often gifting to be included in a worship service. All "<i>Blessings</i>" take place during Sunday morning Worship at 9:30 a.m. unless otherwise noted.</p>
